Sometimes, God will put us into a position where we have to fully depend on HIM with none of our own resources to rely on. Is there a **hard place** HE has you in right now; a <u>difficult relationship</u> you have to deal with; <u>physical issues</u> that you're not able to overcome; or possibly a <u>financial hardship</u>? What is it? Then, ask yourself what could God be trying to teach me or what type of work is HE doing in me or those around me through these events?



Walking on The Spirit __ Confess, Repent, Learn, Adjust Weekly POWER Passage (Write out each day) Read Luke 13....Listen and Apply __ Jesus starts this chapter with a lesson on repentance. This can be a confusing subject. First, we aren't to compare ourselves to others, only to Jesus. God has given us the ability to turn from sin and toward God. The rest of the chapter is based on this concept of **repentance**. It's not about being sorry for your sin; it's about making a change in your life so that you don't sin in that area anymore. In the area of sexual sin, it means turning from the pornography, lustful thoughts, prostitutes, affairs, massage parlors, strip clubs, etc. and turning your eyes and thoughts to God. ___V1-8 give the impression there is a time limit for **salvation**. If you don't show fruit, you are pulled from the ground. That's a misinterpretation of the scripture. If someone has a "true heart salvation" and are repentant in sin, and are showing the fruit of repentance they won't be pulled up. Have you had a true heart salvation and are repentant when you sin? If not, seek the Lord for true salvation. Write out why you believe you are surely saved? __ In V18-20, Jesus teaches about the **Kingdom of God** on earth and in our hearts. It starts small and grows BIG. Describe what has happened in your spiritual life through the years and how God has grown it. Focus on what God has done, not your __ Jesus was dealing with a lot of people who were not really saved. They did not fully believe in Jesus as the way. They had one foot in the world and one foot in religion (the law). In V22-30, Jesus talks about the narrow road; the road of salvation. This road isn't hard (because it's a free gift; you don't have to work for it), rather few people chose this road, because it seems like it would be hard! Make a list of those you know who are on the wide road to hell? What could you do to bring them to the narrow road? Prayer/Quote/Challenge/Principle __ Pray, Jesus quide me down the narrow road and keep me from temptation. Amen! Reflect on how God wants to use you to bring men on to this narrow road. Nothing in all of life brings such satisfaction.
