

REFLECTION: Read the chapter all the way through today!

The chapter starts off with Dustin's SALVATION story and his thoughts about GOD and CHURCH at that time. Dustin shares about going to church after the crisis of his second divorce on pages 47-48. He says, "How could God possibly forgive someone like me—a sexual pervert enslaved to pornography?" Can you relate to his feelings of guilt, shame and unworthiness? How so? Describe how your sexual sin has caused these feelings?

START RIGHT: CONFESS | LEARN | ADJUST

REFLECTION:

PORNOGRAPHY is the entry level drug to sexual sin. Most men are introduced to PORN between 8-12 yrs old with fantasy & masturbation behavior starting soon after. This fantasy world for many men was daily! If he started at age 10, by 21 a young man has had 4,015 sexual experiences in his mind with multiple women. If he has looked at porn for an hour a day, by 21 he has spent almost 6 months of his life (24/hrs a day) looking at porn videos and fantasizing. This is called his happy place. Over the years he learns he can run to this place for relief from stress, failures, belittlement, rejection, boredom...and the list goes on! THIS IS HOW MOST MEN BECOME ADDICTED TO PORN!

PORNOGRAPHY is defined on page 55. It's the emotional, spiritual, and physical abuse of people performing profane acts of sexuality for the arousal of a viewer or audience. Porn "divorces the dignity" of the person made in the image of God from his/her sexuality.

DAY 2

START RIGHT: CONFESS | LEARN | ADJUST

REFLECTION:

One of the main recovery principles in all programs is that there can be no secrets or lying, and you must remain completely open and honest with others. Why do you think this is so important? (This assumes you're doing this with safe people.)

God tells us how "Adam and Eve" responded when they sinned...

- "When the cool evening breezes were blowing, the man and his wife heard the Lord God walking about in the garden. So they hid from the Lord God among the trees." Gen. 3:8
- > Have you been hiding from the Lord like Adam? How have you been hiding? Why have you been hiding?
- > Have you been hiding your sin from your wife, your friends, your pastor, and others? Why? How did that work for you until you got caught or until you will get caught?
- > How long have you been hiding? What is preventing you from moving from the darkness into the light?

To confess your sin to someone at first seems like the hardest thing you will ever have do in life! You're not sure how others will respond? What will they think of you? What will the consequences be? What will your wife say? Your pastor? Your girlfriend, fiancé, or your friends? CONFESSION does bring consequences, BUT the result is so freeing... no more hiding... no more pretending you're someone you're not! It's good to be able to just be you with all the good, bad, and ugly stuff about YOU. We all got Ugly!

Dustin shares on pages 50-51 that he went into hiding and self-protection mode in order to protect himself and keep people from discovering his sexual sin. He states that in reality, being alone drove him into <u>depression</u> > then <u>hopelessness</u> > and eventually <u>suicidal</u> thoughts. He felt like he was in a self-imposed prison. How has trying to protect yourself and others from the knowledge of your sexual sin affected you? Anxiety? Paranoia? Stress? Anger? Sleeplessness? Joyless unless acting out? Dishonesty? Lying? Hypocrite? Etc.? List the top "3" effects. Why would you want to change each of these?

The Bible doesn't use the word MASTURBATION so some believe this is a pass to do what they want, but there are plenty of scriptures that make it clear this type of behavior is destructive. We rarely see a man get free from sexual sin who is unwilling to stop masturbating. After reading these Scriptures, write down how you think God feels when you masturbate.
