~ ...V10:3 For the wicked boasts of his heart's desire, And the greedy man curses and spurns the Lord. V4 The wicked, in the haughtiness of his countenance, does not seek Him. All his thoughts are, "There is no God...V11 God has forgotten...V13 He won't call me to account..."

~ Many ancient manuscripts combine Psalm 9&10 into one psalm. There are four I WILL statements that David makes in V9:1-2. Many think he sang this after a victory over the Philistines. The Challenge

~ Psalm 9 shows us the RIGHTEOUS believe in God's loving care for them. In Psalm 10, we see the UNRIGHTEOUS believe that there is no God, and if there is, He isn't personally involved and won't discipline us. We, as CHRISTIANS, often respond the same way! When we don't see HIM disciplining us for our sin, we think HE must not care. Or we feel like we are getting away with it because there has been no punishment so far. Read Ecclesiastes 8:12. Ask yourself, "Do I keep sinning in certain areas because there are no apparent consequences?" If this is part of your thinking, confess and repent right now for using God's grace and patience as a reason to keep sinning. Then feel the joy of being free!!

Connection Passage - Psalm 1:1-3 & 6

- ~ As you are reading each Psalm, it is fun to keep in perspective that the words were designed to be sung in worship and praise to God! Try making a tune in your mind to go along with the lyrics.
- ~ The Psalms were written over a 1000 year span from 1410 B.C. to 400 B.C. by over ten different writers. David wrote at least 73 of the Psalms. The book of Psalms and Proverbs are the two most read books of the Bible. The book of Psalms is actually broken into five books. There are 10 different types of Psalms and the most famous is considered to be Ps 23:1, "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want." Enjoy your journey through this amazing book of the Bible!
- ~ V1 Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. V2 BUT his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on His law he meditates day and night. V3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yield its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers....V6 For the Lord watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
- ~ This is the Psalm of two ROADS. You get to choose the path you will take. You can choose to be either BLESSED UP or MESSED UP! One of the areas that really affects our lives perhaps more than any other is WHO we hang with, WHO we get advice from, and WHO we work with. Read these two scriptures: 1) 1Cor 15:33 and 2) 2Cor 6:14-16

Connection Passage - Psalm 7:8-12, 14-17

- ~ V8 The Lord judges the peoples; judge me, O Lord, according to my righteousness and according to the integrity that is in me. V9 Oh, let the evil of the wicked come to an end, and may You establish the righteous— You who searches the minds and hearts, O righteous God! V10 My shield is with God, who saves the upright in heart. V11 God is a righteous judge, and a God who feels indignation every day. V12 If a man does not repent, God will whet his sword..... V14 Behold, the wicked man conceives evil and is pregnant with mischief and gives birth to lies. V15 He makes a pit, digging it out, and falls into the hole that he has made. The Challenge

~ God's ability to search our "minds and our hearts" in V9 can be a very scary thing, or it can be very comforting. You can't fake Him out! You can't hide your sin. He knows every motive behind your behavior. NOTHING CAN BE HIDDEN! Scary or comforting? The good news is you don't have to perform for Him because He knows when you aren't being real. You don't have to try and impress Him! He made you and formed you! HE KNOWS YOU! Because He knows you intimately, YOU can TRUST HIM 100%. This is the comforting side of His Knowledge! He chose you knowing everything about you! He wants to work through your weaknesses with you. He lets you make your own choice to earnestly seek Him or to do what you FEEL is best for you! But He rewards those who earnestly seek Him! Hebrews 11:6

Connection Passage - Psalm 3:1-8

- ~ V1 Lord, how many are my foes! How many rise up against me! V2 Many are saying of me, "God will not deliver him." V3 But you, <u>Lord, are a shield</u> around me, my glory, the One who lifts my head high. V4 I call out to the Lord, and <u>He answers</u> me from His holy mountain. V5 I lie down and sleep; I wake again, because the <u>Lord sustains me</u>. V6 I will not fear though tens of thousands assail me on every side. V7 Arise, Lord! Deliver me, my God! Strike all my enemies on the jaw; break the teeth of the wicked. V8 From the <u>Lord comes deliverance</u>. May Your blessing be on Your people.
- ~ This is a Psalm about DAVID fleeing from his rebellious son, ABSALOM, and a host of other traitors who long to seize the throne. In times like this, we can wonder where God is? But this moment in time is a result of David's disobedience to God; sleeping with Bathsheba resulted in the birth of ABSALOM from a Canaanite woman. As you read this Psalm, replace David's "foes" with someone who is trying to oppose you or <a href="mailto:asin in your life that seems determined to destroy you.
- \sim Psalm 3 describes four different ways how the Lord is with us during times of opposition. Think of a time you have felt attacked or opposed and describe how God was with you in each of the four ways below:
- > MY SHIELD (V3)-
- > MY ANSWER (V4)-
- > MY SUSTAINER (V5) -
- > MY DELIVER (V7-8) -

The Challenge

- ~ When circumstances seem to have turned against you, you have a choice to make: 1) You can **Blame God** or 2) **Seek God**. We often get stuck in these times by what I call "GENIE THEOLOGY." We change our prayers from "requests" into "wishes." We expect to "rub" our magic lamp the right way and God will give us what we want. If God grants us our wishes, then HE is a good and powerful God. But if He doesn't do what we are "commanding" Him to do, then we start to question Him, HIS power and His love for us.
- ~ In David's story we don't see God immediately remove David from the terrible circumstances coming against him, but we do see how God is <u>WITH</u> David in all four ways listed above. When David fled from Saul for nearly seven years, he lived in caves daily battling for his life. GOD SHIELDED him from harm, ANSWERED his prayer for protection, SUSTAINED him with food and safety, and ultimately DELIVERED him! It probably wasn't what David had in mind when he asked God to deliver him from Saul.
- ~ How about you? Will you trust God fully even when you don't see HIM ANSWERING your prayers the way you want or as fast as you want? Are you asking Him to answer your prayers yet walking in willful disobedience? Are you experiencing the consequences of your sin and now wondering why God doesn't fix the issues because you have stopped sinning?

I've been there and done that! I found VICTORY IN SURRENDER....and you will too!

<u>A God Moment</u> - Rededicate your entire life to HIM now! Accept HIS forgiveness!

~ MAKE SURE YOU DO THIS EACH DAY - Confess, repent, replace false beliefs, connect.

Connection Passage - Psalms 4:2-4 & 7-8

- ~ V2 How long, O you sons of men, will you turn My glory to shame? How long will you love worthlessness (delusions) and seek falsehood (lies)? V3 But know that the Lord has set apart for Himself him who is godly; the Lord will hear when I call to Him. V4 Be angry, and do not sin. Meditate within your heart on your bed, and be still..... V7 You have put gladness in my heart, more than in the season that their grain and wine increased. V8 I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; for You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.
- ~ Are you glorifying God with your life or are you bringing Him dishonor? V2 If dishonor, don't be shamed by this. Instead ask yourself, "What do I need to change in order to GLORIFY HIM?"
- \sim V3 Do you believe the Lord hears you and will respond to you when you call on HIM? What is this belief based on? What is the truth?
- ~ V7 Speaks of two types of joy. 1) **Inward** joy that comes from knowing and trusting God 2) Happiness, not joy, that comes from **outward** and pleasant circumstances. What brings you joy inwardly? Outwardly?

The Challenge

Pursuit of sexual sin or anything we are trying to find joy from outside of God will lead to destruction and, maybe worse, sleepless nights! ;-} Rom 8:6 "The mind set on the flesh is DEATH, but the mind that is controlled by the Spirit is LIFE & PEACE!" God says there are consequences to the choices we make. Our choices will not all be perfect. Walk in God's grace and mercy, but learn from HIM that HIS ways are best, guaranteed! Memorize Romans 8:6 and remind yourself of this truth every time temptation knocks at your door!!

Connection Passage - Psalm 5:3-7 & 11-12

~ V3 In the morning, Lord, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait expectantly. V4 For you are not a God who is pleased with wickedness; with you, evil people are not welcome. V5 The arrogant cannot stand in your presence. You hate all who do wrong; V6 you destroy those who tell lies. The bloodthirsty and deceitful you, Lord, detest. V7 But I, by **Your great love**, can come into your house; in **reverence** I bow down toward Your holy temple..... V11 But let all who take refuge in You be glad. V12 Surely, Lord, You bless the righteous; You surround them with Your favor as with a shield.

>>>> REFLECT FOR A MOMENT ON WHAT YOU JUST READ <<<<

- ~ Most people find if they don't have a special time set apart with God in the morning they don't get that time later. I believe this is one of the secrets to a CLOSE RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD. Read Phil 4:4-7. Try praying A.C.T.S. to build routine in your morning.
- > "A" Adoration (Worship HIM in words, and tell HIM who He is to you, e.g., Redeemer, Lord, Creator, Counselor, Peace, etc.)
- > "C" Confess & Repent (Admit to God you know you are guilty of sinning against Him and your willingness to turn from your sin. Be specific.)
- > "T" Thanksgiving (Tell God everything that comes to your mind that you're thankful for. Ask Him to show you new things to be thankful for each day.)
- > "S" Supplication (Humbly make requests to God in Expectation He will answer! Trust Him to do the right thing in the right time!)
- ~ The second part to a CLOSER RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD is "Waiting in Expectation" (V3) knowing with confidence that He hears you. Write a note to God telling Him how you will trust Him with your life.

The Challenge

Ask yourself truthfully if you are ARROGANT (V5)? ARE YOU A LIAR (V6)? ARE YOU DECEITFUL (V6)? What does the Psalm say God thinks about people who live like this? This is the time to honestly talk to God about these areas of your life that need an overhaul! Then rejoice in V7! His "great love" was to send His Son to die for all your sin! He WANTS you and He personally CHOSE YOU to LIVE with HIM in His HOLY TEMPLE that now dwells inside of you. C'MON!!! He simply wants a deep relationship with you! Ask yourself what your response should be to HIS GREAT LOVE!
